


APPELLATION CÔTES DU RHÔNE CONTRÔLÉE

CÔTES DU RHÔNE



This generous and friendly early-drinking wine is produced from a blend of 50% Grenache, 30% Syrah and 20% Mourvèdre. Founded in 1965, Les Vignerons d'Estézargues is located in the Gard département on the 'wrong' side of the Rhône, some 20 kilometres west of Avignon.

The winery handles fruit sourced from almost 400 hectares of vines, classified mostly as Côtes du Rhône. In the cellar, only natural yeast fermentations are employed and sulphur levels are kept to an absolute minimum. Neither is there any fining or filtration on any of the red wines.

The blason illustrated is that of the village.
