
## FRUITIÈRE VINICOLE D'ARBOIS

APPELLATION CRÉMANT DU JURA CONTRÔLÉE







Tucked between the foothills of the Alps and Burgundy, the Jura is France's most confidential vineyard region. It is also responsible for some of the country's most individual wines, notably the famous Vin Jaune or 'yellow wine' which is aged in barrel under the influence of flor yeast for seven years before release.

Crémant rosé is produced by the Jura's largest and oldest co-operative. These are referred to locally as Fruitières. This Rosé is a blend of three grapes local to the region: Pinot Noir, Poulsard and Chardonnay. The base wine is co-fermented before being committed to bottle. The second fermentation is conducted in bottle, then aged on the lees for 12 months.

The result is a sparkling wine which displays a fine mousse and pure red fruit profile.
