



## PINOT NOIR

### IGP PAYS D'OC RED 2019

*Pinot Noir is the signature of the best Burgundy 'crus', the most prestigious, elegant and fine wines. Our Pinot Noir coming from the foothills of the Pyrenees give the best expression of these qualities.*

#### Terroir

The vineyard is located at about 300 m. high, on a long running slope at the foothills of the Pyrenees. Vines are planted West to give freshness to the wine. The light gravel soils allow the best conditions for the Pinot noir grapes.

#### Grape varieties

Pinot Noir (18 years old)

#### Winemaking

Bush Vine, Dry grown. Hand harvested with selection of the best grapes.

50% of the grapes are whole cluster fermented. Alcoholic fermentation at 28°C. Very soft extraction (no pumping over, no rack and return). Aging in demi-muids on fine lees for 6 months.

#### Tasting Notes

This perfumed red wine shows a nice concentration, a lot of freshness and dark fruit complex aromas. On the palate, the wine is mineral, intense and full-bodied with a long elegant finish.

Pair with meats, grilled tuna, mushroom risotto, or creamy cheeses

Aging potential: 8 years.
