Cornet & Cie Red wine has been carefully selected from our best Collioure vineyard for its pure and intense aromatic expression

Terroir

The Collioure vineyard is located in Roussillon in the far South of France, where the Pyrenees meet the Mediterranean sea. Vines grow on arid steep schist terraces overlooking the sea.

Grape varieties

Syrah 50% - Grenache 35% - Mourvèdre 15%

Winemaking

Yield: 25 hl/ha. Grapes are hand harvested in small buckets, destemmed and crushed. Maceration for 25 days. Carbonic maceration for 10% of the Grenache. Racking after malolactic fermentation. Aging in topped-up tank; 40% of the blend is aged in demi-muid barrels for 12 months.

“Boasting a wondrous array of cherries, strawberries, stone fruit and spice on the nose, it seamlessly moves into a silky, medium to full-bodied feel on the palate.
