Terroir

The vineyard of Banyuls is located at the extreme South of France, where the Pyrénées meet the Mediterranean sea. The vines grow on terraces, on steep slopes of arid schist. They define the whole landscape from the seashore to the deepest valleys of the Roussillon.

The vines are planted on the steep and narrow terraces on schisteous soil, along sunny creeks and hills. These steep hills can only be worked by hands.

Grape varieties

80% Grenache, 20% Carignan

Winemaking

Maceration of crushed and partially destemmed grapes. Malolactic fermentation. Aging: over-oxidation in broached casks outdoors.

Tasting Notes

"It's nutty and aldehydic on the nose, then medium to full-bodied on the palate, with dry, assertive flavors of walnuts, plus hints of caramel and honey. Serve it as an aperitif or with the cheese course."
