**GRAPE-GROWING CHARACTERISTICS:**

Soil type: glacial moraine clay-limestone soil

Exposure: south-west

Altitude: 400 to 500 m

Average age of grapevines: 39 years

Density of planting: 6000 vine plants/hectare, spacing  
2.10 m between rows

Training method: vines trained on wires, guyot pruning  
(single)

Ground care: permanent grassing between rows,  
chemical weed control under the rows

Work on the growing vines is carried out to ensure a  
very high-quality grape harvest: removing unwanted  
new shoots, disbudding double eyes, thinning out the  
leaves, cluster thinning if necessary.

**Our domain has been certified “High Environmental Value” since November 2016. (We obtained “Sustainable Agriculture” certification in December 2006).**

**WINE PRODUCTION CHARACTERISTICS:**

Grapes harvested manually

Conveyor sorting

Thermovinification

Devatting with conveyor belt

Pneumatic pressing
