APPELLATION: Roussette de Savoie

REGION: South-east France

VINTAGE: 2020

GRAPE VARIETY: Altesse

GRAPE-GROWING CHARACTERISTICS:

Soil type: deposit of glacier torrent stony, sandy, clay-limestone soil
Exposure: south-west
Altitude: 400 to 500 m
Average age of grapevines: 33 years
Density of planting: 6000 vine plants/hectare, spacing 2.10 m between rows
Training method: vines trained on wires, guyot pruning (single)
Ground care: permanent grassing between rows, chemical weed control under the rows
Work on the growing vines is carried out to ensure a very high-quality grape harvest: removing unwanted new shoots, disbudding double eyes, thinning out the leaves.

Our domain has been certified “High Environmental Value” since November 2016. (We obtained “Sustainable Agriculture” certification in December 2006).

WINE PRODUCTION CHARACTERISTICS:

Grapes harvested manually
Pneumatic pressing
Thermovinification
No malolactic fermentation

Waste products are stored in a special tank and then spread on permanent grassland.
