Domaine **Le Clos Rouge** was created in 2013 by Krystel Brot-Weissenbach and Joël Peyre.

Located in Saint-Jean-de-la Blaquière, in the Languedoc, in the heart of the AOC Terrasses du Larzac on an altitude terroir where we find red ruffles (dating from the Permian period, 300 million year) and schists. These terroirs bring structure and minerality to the wines.

The entire vineyard is cultivated organically

Dégustation : an elegant, delicate wine, full of finesse. Crunchy red fruits on the attack, ending with the spicy and peppery notes typical of this essential Languedoc grape variety.

Nature du sol : Ruffles end schists

Vignes : 40 to 60years old, in gobelets

Rendement : 25 hL/ha

Vinification :

- The harvest is manual, in boxes of 10-20 kg.
- Total destemming, indigenous yeasts.
- Strict temperature control
- Light pressing, reasoned extraction for tasting and short maceration.

Elevage : 8 mois, cuve

millésime 2015 : Melted nose, very cherry, stone, cut hay, spices and menthol, round, velvety, aromatic palate, silky and fresh tannins, liveliness on the finish. Easy and delicious.
