The nose is deep and powerful. Its bouquet ranges from ripe fruit to black olives, with spicy and liquorice notes, sometimes going sometimes as far as zan.

A very ample mouth, built with ripe tannins. A sustained concentration mixed with a long aromatic persistency.

The delicate expression of a powerful, ambitious and true terroir.

Conversion to organic farming to the vintage 2020.
