A beautiful aromatic complexity supported by a delicate minthy freshness.

A full and balanced mouth accompanied by a refined opulence which is followed by a beautiful length all in finesse. Bitterness at the end of the mouth make salivate and brings a subtle complexity.

A refined and elegant white wine, rich in aromas and enjoying an exemplary balance.

Conversion to organic farming to the vintage 2020.
