Anubis is a reverent tribute to the Cabernet Sauvignon variety, which has rested humbly within Barossa Valley's wine growing history for many generations. Single vineyard, personally selected fruit from a dedicated Barossa grower creates a wine which is a true testament to this noble variety.

TASTING NOTES

Lévrier Wines

Crafted to enhance rich, dark cherry and cassis fruit, the bouquet is extensive with red currant and mulberry aromas. The colour of intense brick red displays careful ageing of the wine, which is signature to Jo Irvine's winemaking style. 40% New French oak results in plush and juicy flavours with an elegant, soft and velvety tannin finish. Extended ageing in the bottle before release integrates the unique characters of this single vineyard, boutique wine – the result is a complex wine that rewards the care and patience invested in it's creation. The 2016 vintage was slightly cooler and wetter throughout the time of fruit set during spring 2015 and into Jan-Feb there were milder conditions with a little rain just at the fortuitous time in January. This allowed for optimal ripening and flavour development.

ANUBIS

Egyptian God of the dead, Anubis is represented as a man with a greyhound dog's head. Depicted as a protector of graves, his role was to usher souls of the dead safely into the afterlife.

Tutankhamen and Cleopatra's many greyhounds were entombed and sometimes mummified with their owners to protect them on their way into royalty afterlife.
