Vintage	2019.	Alcohol	14.0% Alc/vol.
Colour	Deep dark purple with red hues.		
Aroma	Lifted aromas of blackberry and plum, dried sage, mint and eucalypt, overlaid with cedar oak notes.		
Palate	An intense and flavour filled palate of rich blackberry and mulberry fruits complemented with sturdy but well balanced tannins.
