Vintage	2019.	Alcohol	14.0% Alc/vol.
Colour	Deep purple with cherry hues.		
Aroma	Lifted aromas of purple and blue fruits, plum overlaid with spice and hint of mocha.		
Palate	Bright fruits rich in flavour, black cherry, with a warm and succulent fruit finish that holds until the end.
