SHIRAZ 2021

Located within the 'Old Town' of Coonawarra this one-acre Shiraz vineyard was planted in the early 1950's. The combination of old-vines, terrior and careful hand-tending produces a wine with a distinguished sense of place and style. Despite its age, the 'House Block' vineyard, located within the township of Coonawarra continues to flourish with deep roots reaching through the Terra-Rossa and Limestone to the pure aquifer below.

Region Coonawarra, South Australia.

Vintage 2021. **Alcohol** 14.% Alc/vol.

Colour Deep garnet with bright red hues.

Aroma Ripe plums with lifted raspberry, cherry and framed with subtle oak.

Palate An elegant palate of ripe red and black fruits, balanced with silky tannins which hold long over the fresh fruits finish.

“Elegant, stylish, medium bodied and pretty. You get my drift. This is quintessential Coonawarra shiraz. Beautifully poised fruit displaying that chalky mouthfeel which permeates the plush fruit on the palate. It comes off vines that are now 70 years old and dry grown. This has the structure with those slightly sinewy tannins and the well managed oak to cellar for many years.”
