VINTAGE REPORT

2021 harvest was good both in quality and quantity. This is a joy and a relief after four harvest with very low crop. We were spared this year from the climate catastrophes that touched many French wine regions.

The wines show a vibrant and fresh profile with beautiful balance and refreshing acidity levels.

This is our first certified organic vintage after the conversion period from 2018 to 2020.

INSPIRATION

Since its first vintage 2013, this wine has found a solid place in our wine range. Impressed by the intense fruit expression that Lirac terroir can offer, we elaborate this wine to show with joyful and elegant characters the complexity of our Cru appellation.

The label is an aquarelle of Montfaucon from 1830s. The two children in the carriage are the young Baron Louis and his sister Wilhelmine.

Sou

Villafranchiennes terraces with rolling pebbles (galets roulés).

GRAPE VARIETIES

60% Grenache, 30% Syrah, 10% Cinsault, Yield max 35hl/ha.

WINE MAKING AND AGING

Hand picking. Total destemming. 15 days of vatting. Bottling after 20 months of aging in concrete tanks.
